# THE LAST LAUGH - Wonderfully British.....


In a train from London to Manchester an American was berating the Englishman sitting across from him in the compartment.

Uncle Peter K.P. Hall has been a Rotarian for 54 years and during that time he has been a mentor to many District Governors. Given the extensive history of his service, it is of no surprise that we call Uncle Peter the 'Walking Encyclopedia of Rotary'. Whatever there is to know, he knows it.

For all of those years, Rotary has been an integral part of his daily life rather than an organization he belongs to. He has literally lived and breathed Rotary, and is a walking example of 'Service above self'. He served as Club President in 1964, and after that, he served as a Club Secretary for 3 years and a Club Treasurer for



another two years. He was also the District Secretary for an extensive stint of 8 whole years!

Uncle Peter is known to every Rotarian in District 3450. He was DG in 1981, when our district was still known as District 345 and included Taiwan and Macau. Uncle Peter Hall has received every award there is to receive from Rotary International and the Rotary Foundation, including: the Service Above Self Award, Meritorious Service Award and the Distinguished Service Award.

Uncle Peter has attended over 20 Rotary International Conventions and also 20 (if not more) Rotary Institutes. It was Uncle Peter who initiated the Rotary Information Centre
