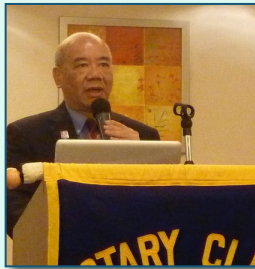

EcoPark is Hong Kong's first recycling-business park, and is a facility of the Environmental Protection Department specially constructed for recycling industry. Situated in Lung Mun Road, Tuen Mun, with a site area of 200,000m², EcoPark has been developed in two phases and provides a rentable area of 140,000m² long term land at affordable costs for the recycling industry.
