SPOTLIGHT ON:

Social Media Marketing for the Restaurant Business

President Norman began by outlining the challenges facing restaurant owners in terms of cost management, and how social media marketing can help business. He stressed the importance of loyalty programmes in branding, and for brands to earn the love and trust of consumers. He then recapped a little history about the development of the internet for brands and marketers, and in particular the arrival of Web 2.0, which revolutionized the relationships companies can have with their customers, allowing for direct interactive participation, exploding the social media phenomenon, with networking and blogging becoming a part of everyday life.

He then gave us some insights into the potential of social media, especially in China where the growth of digital users is enormous. There are 4 key steps for any business to follow to get its own social media platform off the ground:



- 1. Build your page
- 2. Connect with people
- 3. Engage your audience
- 4. Influence friends of fans

Norman then went into some successful case studies of restaurant businesses using social media well for their marketing objectives, utilising APPS and directly online reservation systems. At the end the message was 'No customers, no business', so – get to know your customers, using social media as your tool!
