Marin Minayama - The Explorer's Grand Slam

Marin delivered such a raw and vulnerable 30 minute sharing of her journey to be the Guinness Book of Record's youngest female to complete the Explorer's Grand Slam. (The youngest person to conquer the world's tallest summits on all seven continents as well as journeying to opposite ends of the globe)

She shared the adversities she faced and how those adversities fueled her determination to defy all odds and venture into climbing. Hiking/climbing was her escape from her turbulent household. The twists and turns in her life inspired her to do something incredible and inconceivable. When she was 17, she was determined that by the age of 20, she would climb Mount Everest. She was determined to be the youngest Japanese female climber. She did not have any financial support from her parents, and hence she wrote hundreds of letters, wrote articles in newspapers to share her story, her passion. Her first backer came from a Grandma who wanted to support her. And what turned out to be a quest to climb Mount Everest, spiraled into a greater quest to finish the Explorer's Grand Slam.

Marin shared with us her photos and so vividly described how it was like when she reached the top of Everest. How the colours changed in the sky, and how tears in her eyes turned to icicles.

Overall, one member commented that Marin's talk was one of the best talks he has heard in the past 7 years.
