Mr. Thomas Hung graduated from Baptist University in 2002. After graduation, he began the outdoor advertising business in 2003 and have recorded more than 200 ad placement in various districts in Hong Kong. He created the "world-first" and patented Double Tube and Ferries Wheels type moving Billboard, Mobile Display Car, Car of stage and moving stage.





He is also the winner of "Innovation Entrepreneur of the Year 2003" organized by City Junior Chamber and "Most Creative Award for LiveWIRE Awards 2004" by Sheel & Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups.

Thomas shared with us on his recent project, Crystal Bus, the first double decker in Hong Kong that combines touring with gourmet experience. First Thomas give us his career background beginning from outdoor advertising, since his career in advertising, he focuses on creative, like he created Double Tube and Ferries Wheel Type moving Billboard. He came up with the idea of Touring Bus plus Good Food when being the host of one of his clients from

overseas, other than shopping, we do not have much choices for tourist and Bus Tour is interesting for tourist and Hong Kong has good reputation on good food, why don't we combine the idea of Tour Bus that

serves good food. Thomas has gone thru tough time to get the bus fully licensed and legal to operate. His spirt and his team supported him to make this mission impossible to possible.
