Speaker Summary

Chris Geary delivered a very eloquent articulate overview of his views on Coding and Education. It is in his belief that coding is a fundamental key for all economies in the future because coding education affects the microeconomics of a city/municipality. That is to say, in the long run, how a government determines its future (10-15 year trajectory) tertiary competitive advantages depends on the current education system.

In Chris' point of View - CoDe-ing is Competency + Design. He said that teaching Coding to young students offers students a chance to be creative and adaptive.

BSD Coding Academy is one of the first educational centres that teach coding. The opportunity in the current market place is that the HK Schooling system is not equipped to teach coding and hence coding classes are outsourced to BSD Coding Academy.

Chris ended his talk with a story how Children are incredibly quick with coding and also very entrepreneurial. One of his students (12 years old) built an App that raised 15,000USD - this student donated all of these funds to a school in Mexico.
