Mr. CHONG Dee Hwa is an ichthyologist, nature historian and nature photographer, specializing in research topics on taxonomy, evolution and geography distribution of fishes of the world. He is the founder and current president of the Ichthyological Society of Hong Kong (ISHK), and, a visiting professor of Department of Life Science, Fudan University of Shanghai.

Mr. Chong's topic was "Biodiversity & Nature Conservation"

As a naturalist and ichthyologists, Mr. Chong introduced to our members the discoveries and research in Natural History in the previous 200 years.

As of today, humanity still has a very limited understandings and knowledge of nature - our planet earth, despite great process in space technology and living standard enhancement have been made. Living

in the hustle and bustle in the cities, less and less people nowadays realize that our lives are very much interconnected with the nature environment. In search of wildlife species: Biodiversity, and, understanding "How Nature Works" are both crucial parts of Nature Conservation.

He further introduced the distinctive natural habitats and living organisms that can be found on Lantau Island, including places like Mui Wo, Tung Chung, Luk Wu and Tai Ho as his study cases.
