Speaker Notes

The speaker in fact turned out to be a "Si Hing" of both PP Hubert and PP Andy in Wing Chun! What a small world! Dr. William Wong had such a variety of topics to share with us (from his experience) however he chose to share his perspective on Narrative Parenting. What is Narrative Parenting? It is communicating with children not only through story...but also through dialogue. It is a parenting style that encourages interaction through dialogue and discussion and asking questions. Children very often may wish to express themselves without a purpose, i.e. expressing part of their day/experience without expecting to be corrected/receive comments by their parents. Dr. William Wong suggests allowing Children to share their stories/idea/points of views. Instead of immediately offering solutions or correcting children, parents could ask leading questions to coach their children along the way.

Dr William share many personal stories of how he used Narrative Parenting in raising his 2 children (boy and girl, both University students now)
