Rotary Information

The world's first service club, the Rotary Club of Chicago, Illinois, USA, was formed on 23 February 1905 by Paul P. Harris, an attorney who wished to recapture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The name "Rotary" derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members'offices. This club met in rotation at the offices of the members, thus the name Rotary. There are now more than 29,000 Rotary clubs with a total Rotary membership of over 1.2 million men and women, serving 172 countries.

As a Rotarian, you are a member of the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Island East, which in turn is a member of Rotary International. The free world is divided into Zones/Regions, which in turn, is divided into territories within which a group of clubs are associated. These territories are known as Rotary Districts. There are 502 districts in the Rotary world (172 countries). Our club is in District 3450, which is comprised of over 90 clubs. Total membership is over 2,400 Rotarians. Rotary International is governed by a President and Board of Directors elected from all over the world. Annually, each District elects a District Governor and each club elects its officers and directors.
