For Professional Development, Cyrus will organize professional development workshops and information sharing especially with start-up companies. There will be 3 activities, first one will be e-sports. Second will be red wine, third will be professional services skills sharing.

For Funding and Sponsorship, Lawrence spoke on behalf of Patrick. Funding team has opened a PayMe account for a unified members due collection. A fund-raising event / Bazaar will be held with service partners, under the theme of environmental protection.

P Luffy expressed that RAC HKIE will support mother club for activities such as Rookie Star, and will send representatives to host club events, and RAC HKIE members will volunteer for Interota 2020.
