

Last meeting, we had two representatives from Hong Chi Association come to speak to our club: Erica Fung and Sue Cheng. Erica shared about the history of Hong Chi Association and the current activities that Hong Chi Association focuses on.

Hong Chi Association acts as a foster home for special needs children. Currently the organization serves 104 children, age from 6 to 18 years old. These children are special needs children (autistic) who come from homes that cannot take care of them, e.g. single-parent homes, parents dealing with drug addiction, parents with social/mental issues. The waitlist to enter Hong Chi Association is 3 years. The turnover is very long, because the retention rate is very hard because once a child enters that child is likely to stay until s/he is 18 years old.

Hong Chi Association works looks after the children around the clock. The children go to school and come back to their dormitories in Hong Chi Association Pine Village. The Association has an array of activities for the students: homework support + other activities. The staff-to-children ratio is 2 staff for every 8 children.

With the help of other charities, the Hong Chi Association can take their children to outings such as "spark! (trampoline)", Ocean Park, Disneyland and others.

The members had many good questions to the speakers, asking about what type of job opportunities are available for these children (answer: hospitality, catering) and more questions regarding the operations of Hong Chi Association. HKIE is dedicated to learn more about this organization because through knowing this organization more we can understand how to serve them better. PE Leo thanked the speakers in our usual Rotarian manner.
