Community Service Project in Progress: English Conversations with the Students from Holy Carpenter

We are currently in the planning stages of a new community service project with the Holy Carpenter School. A pilot test for this programme will ideally have 10 students to start with. PP Stacy will update everyone on the progress of this project. This project will be launched with Mercury Education.
