Last Meeting: Royan Lam - Children's Kidney Fund

The Children's Kidney Fund is the established NGO that received the 20,000 children mask our club sponsored in cooperation with Colour Away Covid. Therefore, it was fitting to invite the Chairman Royan Lam to share with us about the organisation.

Royan had the desire to contribute to CKF in any capacity so he started his volunteering his time and skills in the administration of CKF over 11 years ago. His passion to serve children facing kidney disease originated from an experience he had at a hospital - he saw a child going through a dialysis treatment.

CKF takes on a holistic approach in the way it serves the community. Its main beneficiaries are children who are at the final stage of their kidney disease. This means that these children are fully dependent on dialysis machines and are on the wait list for organ donation. CKF not only provides monetary support, but also and more importantly focuses on helping families with their social and emotional needs.

For most families who have a child in the final stage of kidney disease, usually one parent would stay home as a caretaker.

Services that CKF provide are:

- Automated Peritoneal Dialysis Programme
- Travelling Allowance for Haemodialysis Treatment
- Post-Kidney Transplantation Drug Programme
- Induction Drug Treatment Subsidy for Kidney Transplantation
- Rituximab Treatment Subsidy
- Support for Research & Training
- Patient and Family Activities
- (NEW) Anti-Coronavirus Programme Subsidy

Chairman Royan gave us full details of the financials of CKF. CKF has donations from corporations on an ad hoc basis. And he answered many questions from our audience.

Our PP Jonathan thanked our speaker. PP Jonathan's son received treatment at the Hong Kong Children's Hospital. From his direct experience, PP Jonathan expressed that when parents discover that their children are ill, they panic. The Children's Hospital focus and resources are on saving the children's lives. The hospitals have little time to give support to the family/parents. PP Jonathan urges for more good Rotarians and good people to help fund the Children's Kidney Fund. We thanked our speaker in our regular Rotarian manner.
