Highlights of Professor Lam's presentation: Objectives of HKCRA:

- Support Early-Education teachers by opening opportunities for exposure in various regions in China to cooperate in the development of child-support activities and exchange activities.
- Promote and organize activities that are charitable and beneficial to early childhood education and moral education in all districts.
- Carry out charitable projects related to disaster relief and poverty alleviation within the financial capacity of the Association, and sponsor other charitable activities deemed appropriate by the Association.
- Cooperate with various Hong Kong community charities to provide various social welfare services and activities for communities in a non-profit-making manner. For example: visit, care and assist people in need.
- Pay attention to matters related to early childhood education and strengthen contacts with local education bureaus, relevant government departments and other organizations.

Service Project: "Sending Warmth" - a service visit to female inmates.

HKCRA organises monthly visits to the Lo Wu Correctional Institution to visit the pregnant inmates. HKCRA also organizes monthly visits to Tai Lam to visit the mothers (and their infants) in custody.


During the visits, HKCRA may arrange activities such as: parent-child games, teaching parenting knowledge, demonstration of nursery rhymes and storytelling skills, prenatal exercises, counseling.

Volunteers who are interested in participating, need to partake in a volunteer training course (delivered by HKCRA) before serving.

Volunteer training dates: February and July (one weekend or two weekday evenings) The scheduled service visits occur on the 2nd Sunday and 3rd Saturday of each month.

Background and Goals of the Go Chess Project:

- Promote the Go culture and help the disadvantaged groups of children to develop and grow by taking advantage of the benefits of learning Go.
- · Through short-term funding, revive the cultural tradition of Go in the Hong Kong community.
- By entrusting professionals to explore the effectiveness (qualitative) of Go as a method to enhance child. This will pave the way for more relevant research in the future.
- With systematic training methods and recognizable open competitions, HKCRA seeks to improve children's Go skills and increase their motivation to learn.
- Provide an opportunity for grassroots students to exchange Go chess skills and cultural exchanges with overseas players.
