Examining Your Company's Business Model

The speakers were experts in their field. They shared with us their passion to support and help companies under go health body checks. They shared with us the following 10 Building Blocks they advise companies on:

Customer segmentation, value proposition, channel, customer relationships, revenue streams, key resources, key activities, key partnerships, cost structures and leadership.

They suggest that companies undergo a health check when they are healthy. However they did mention that it is never too late to establish a health-check process.

In their opinion, in today's world, every company is a technology company (in some sense) it is how a company chooses to apply the technology that makes an impact.

During this time of Covid, both Foster Yiu and Claudius Tsang offered a suggestion for companies to focus internally at their personnel. They brought to our attention how the nature of work now includes remote working (e.g. via Zoom or Microsoft Teams) so it is ever more important at the moment to foster strong relationships with employees, build loyalty and also create a sense of appreciation so that the employees feel valued.
