Speech of our Speaker- Samantha Gale (introduced by Rotarian Joseph Tse)

Samantha is one of Hong Kong's inbound Rotary Ambassadorial Scholars for 2012-2013. She is sponsored by the Rotary Club of Bury St. Edmunds, District 1080 in England and her host club here in Hong Kong is the Rotary Club of Queensway.

She is a doctor, having graduated from Cambridge University in 2010, and is currently studying for the Master of Public Health (MPH) at Hong Kong University. At HKU, she has been awarded the Professor Anthony J Hedley scholarship for Master of Public Health and a CEDARS Gold Award for volunteer service to HKU students. This September she will begin her Paediatric residency in the UK. Her professional interests are child health, health service improvement and equity, social epidemiology and health policy.

For Samantha's background, she talked about having a blessed childhood in Nottingham, full of opportunity and positive role-models; her studies and dancing at Cambridge University; working in the NHS whilst volunteering with children with social needs and studying clinical leadership with the Open University.

She also talked about how her Rotary Ambassadorial scholarship year had been a year of learning: both in her Master of Public Health course at HKU but also out of the classroom. She have experienced life as an immigrant with it's challenges (accessing culture, difficulties in simple everyday tasks which are done differently in different countries, observing discrimination and how this can quickly influence how you think). The benefits she talked about were making friends, learning new things about Hong Kong and China and having the courage to try new things.

To summarize, she challenged us all to think about our role in public health; appreciate the crucial role of understanding history in understanding people and our differences; use the 4-way test to avoid spreading discrimination; make the parts of our culture we are most proud of accessible to visitors; make new friends and try new things.

PP Tim Lui gave a vote of thanks to Samantha in our usual Rotary manner, he mentioned that through her presentation, accepting different cultural behavior especially more Chinese visitors visiting Hong Kong and the reminder from Samantha of the Rotary 4-ways test, "Is it FAIR to all concerned ? Will it build Goodwill and better friendships?" helps to build a better community.

PP Tim Lui wished all these cultural experiences in Hong Kong will bring Samantha a better perspective in her future career in Public Health, PP Tim Lui, PP John Kwok and Pres. Jonathan then presented Samantha with a photo and a Lai See as a token of appreciation to wish her a bright future.

The meeting was then adjourned at 2:00pm with a toast to Rotary Club of HK Island East and Rotary Club of Bury St. Edmunds, District 1080, we all stayed behind for a photo session.

Wonderful World of Maths

A mother is 21 years older than the child.

6 years from now the mother will be 5 times as old as the child.

Question : Where's the father right now ?

(25 Marks)

Try first, before you check the answer below.

-- Whoever calculated this one must be one hell of a mathematician # #.

Solution:

The mother is 21 years older than the child.

$$M = C + 21$$

In 6 years from now the mum will be 5 times as old as the child.

$$M + 6 = (C + 6) \times 5$$

Hence,

$$C + 21 + 6 = (C + 6) \times 5$$

$$C + 27 = 5C + 30$$

$$-3 = 4C$$

$$C = -3/4$$

The child is - 3/4 years old, Minus 3/4 years, that is, it'll be born in 9 months.

Thus... by mathematical deduction... :

Right now, the father is on top of the mother.....
