- Fund Raising Program for service projects this year was targeted at HK\$ 200,000 which begins until Aug 31, 2011. President Eric encouraged members to support this campaign. Up to now, 50% of the target is met.

The red box collection was HK\$3,800 with special contributions from DG David, DGE Kenneth, DGN Eugene and DS Peter Pang.

DG David Harilela was then introduced by President Eric to deliver his speech. He mentioned that Hong Kong Island East was the first club that he visited as we were well prepared for it, and he complimented President Eric for an excellent job in club planning, and he was very much impressed by his Inaugural Speech. DG David was jokingly saying that he may even consider inviting President Eric to speak to other clubs.

DG David thanked Hong Kong Island East for our support to District, in particular, District Inaugural Ball Chair PP Eddy who had done an outstanding job and everyone participated enjoyed the event. He also urged our members to participate in the RI Convention next year in Bangkok as it is in the region and very close to us. He would also extend his hospitality to participating members if we were to stay in Holiday Inn in Bangkok.

President Eric then presented his gift to DG David, which was the Hong Kong Island East T-shirt; he also presented gifts to DGE Kenneth, DGN Eugene, DS Peter and RIC Administration Manager Rainy.

IPP Heman invited DG David to present the Avenue of Services Award to our President Eric for his contributions to Rotary movement, he then taken the opportunity to thank his board members, who missed the Club Installation last week, with his token of appreciations.

President Eric led a team of members consisted of PP Uncle John, PE Nancy, Membership Service Chair William Wong and his wife Fanny, Rtn. Jonah Cheung kicked off the 1<sup>st</sup> Community Service Project with the Tea Party for 26 elderly singletons in Tai Hang Sai Estate, Shek Kip Mei on July 22, 2011.

The team arrived at the center at 11:20 am. After a short briefing, we warmly welcomed and greeted the elderlies with chats as an ice-breaking conversation. President Eric introduced our Club briefly and introduced all members to the attending elderly. Then, we started playing games. Members also sang songs to the elderlies. Afterwards, we distributed the food and started the lunch party. The party ended at 1 pm with a group photo taken together. The beneficiaries all enjoyed the service and expressed that they would certainly join our service again next month. Serving members all agreed that this was a meaningful project for "Reach Within to Embrace Humanity" and would not miss the chance to 'Serve Above Self' next month.

The service project will include 5 luncheon parties on weekdays and 3 outings in Saturday afternoon which will be held once monthly from July 2011 to Feb 2012. Members, their dependents, rotaractors and students from our school partners will be encouraged to join. The aim of this humanitarian project is to provide continual care to elderly singletons, health promotion by enhancing their interpersonal contacts with members to prevent age-segregation of elderly from community.
