President Eric then introduced the speaker Mr. Sunny Yan, the Hon. Secretary of the Rotary Club of Peninsula. His topic of presentation is "Some possibility in Photography".

Mr Yan explained the reason for our love for photography is that people trust their eyes before words. A picture is worth more than a thousand words.

He defined photography as an art which we utilize light to form an image by using camera and lens, Xerox or scanner which may be recorded in films or digital form.

Modern photography was invented by Jacob Mande Daguerre in 1833. He first exposed silver-coated copper plates to iodine obtaining silver iodide. Then he exposed them to light for several minutes, coated the plate with mercury vapor heated to 75° Celsius (to amalgamate the mercury with the silver) and finally fixing the image in salt water. These ideas led to the famous Daguerreotype.

He then discussed the functions and advantages of different type of lenses like the wide angle lens, fish eye lens, ultra-long focal length lens, zoom lens and the macro lens. A discussion in depth was then made on the use of photography.

Family record, social documentation, capturing of landscape and portraiture are the initial use of photography. It creates new forms of beauty and nostalgic feeling.

Photojournalism is developed subsequently and it creates a huge impact on the attitudes of the public towards political event.

When photography is applied to the commercial field like advertising and the fashion industry, tremendous growth in new technique has developed. Photo fabrication, photo collage, applied optical aberration and light painting can create fascinating pictures that capture the eyes and mind of the customer. The rise of surrealism also provides an additional way for photographer to present their works in an abstract style. Mr. Yan showed us some of his fascinating work which amazed us all.

Photography has also been used to criticize culture and context. It also has application in medicine, art therapy, visual investigation and research.

After Mr. Yan finished his excellent presentation, our SAA William Leung represented our club to give the vote of thanks to our speaker.

President Eric then announced that the next week meeting would be a Joint Meeting with RC HK North East and the speaker would be Ms. Jenny Quinton, Director of Ark Eden Foundation. The Ark of Eden foundation is a charity organization that promotes environmental education, eco, historical and cultural heritage preservation and sustainable life style through projects, workshops, camps, eco-tours, fieldtrips, etc. Jenny will show cases of the works of the Foundation at the joint meeting.

Finally, all Rotarian and guests were invited to have a group photo and the meeting adjourned at 2:10pm.
