After Pres. Jonathan's announcements Sergeant-At-Arm Jonah Cheung reported that the red box collection was HK\$1,700.

Chief District Secretary PP Eric Chin introduced the background of Mr. Charles Lam, who was a CFA and joined Baring Private Equity Asia as Managing Director, Real Estate in November, 2011, based in Hong Kong with primary focus on Greater China real estate investments. Mr. Lam had very substantial real estate investment in Greater China, such as with Pramerica Real Estate Investors, a subsidiary of Prudential Financial U.S. and one of the largest real estate investors in the world, during his 4-year stay with PREI Mr. Lam had managed over US\$1 billion of real estate investments, refinancing, and disposition projects in China and in Hong Kong.

Mr. Charles Lam had a research interest in real estate and he would be presenting his DBA thesis to Hong Kong Polytechnic University soon for his oral examination. Mr. Lam was kind enough to share his research findings with us in the layman term, regarding the topic about whether or not an investor sentiment would affect the pricing of residential property in Hong Kong and examining the association between sentiment and future price movement of Hong Kong residential properties.

Mr. Lam shared some interesting facts about the residential property background with us:

- We had nearly 2.6 million flat units in HK for our 7.136 million people (as of March 2012).
- Among them are 1.45 million of flat units from private segment (about 56%), and the remaining 1.15 millions of flat units from the public segment (about 44%)
- Centa-City Leading Index (中原城市指數) was a popular residential pricing index in Hong Kong from a real estate agent, to show an increase of 98.8% between 2001-2010.
- Whereas the Hong Kong median income from census data, only showing an 9.5% increase from HK\$18,710 in Year 2001 to HK\$20,500 in Year 2010.

Mr. Lam did his data collections for 15 residential projects in HK, Kowloon and the New Territories regarding their property pricing and real estate returns, over a twenty-year period. Mr. Lam's research focus was the investment sentiment, being measured by a compiled investor sentimental index for residential properties, first of its kind in Hong Kong.

Mr. Lam had briefly outlined his statistical research using data regression model, to fit a trend line, to make assumptions and testing on its predictive power. The data was from the property pricing and return in 15 residential estates covering (different class from A to E), covering from both Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories. Mr. Lam compiled an investor sentiment index based on his research parameter (factors), and made a fair comparison with the trend of Centa-City Index over the same 20-year period.

His research was an application of behavioral finance, a modeling from investor sentiment and in relation to price level as well as investment return, and to review its theoretical and empirical evidence for these predictions in the Hong Kong property market. The research finding showed a negative correlation of the pricing and the investor sentiment (with 3-15 months time lag), and also more particular to small size units for their economic returns.

To thank the speaker, Rtn. Jason Chiu (another CFA) pointed out rightly that the US share market had already adopted various measurements for investor activity for market clues and those readings of investor sentiment could be important. Some investor sentiment research reports were even published by large investment firms or research firms, which periodically poll their clients to determine market consensus. Nevertheless Rtn. Jason had applauded the initiative of our speaker for his innovative use of the investor sentiment index for the Hong Kong residental property market.

Rtn. Jason thanked the speaker for his informative talk in our usual Rotary manners.

Pres. Jonathan adjourned the meeting in time, and reminded the members that he would be joining DG Eugene and PP Eric in their Mongolian visit on September 11, when IPP Nancy had agreed to step in to chair the meeting for him. Also September 18 (Wednesday) would be Uncle Peter golf event, and the dinner meeting would be in the evening, joining other clubs in Area 3 as well, for advance Mid-Autumn Festival celebration. Pres. Jonathan proposed a toast to RI coupled with RC of Wanchai, Hong Kong Harbour and Hong Kong North. The guests and members all stayed for a group photo at end.


