Ms. Jasmine Hogan, a native of Raleigh, NC, began playing the harp in 1998 at the age of eight. Jasmine has worked with numerous orchestras and ensembles, and has appeared as a soloist not only in the US, but also in Hungary, Switzerland, and Singapore.

In November, Jasmine participated in the Second International Harp Competition in Szeged, where she was awarded Third Prize in her division. Jasmine recently graduated from the Peabody Conservatory in May 2011, with a Bachelor's degree in harp performance. Currently Jasmine is studying the traditional Chinese harp in Beijing as a Rotary International Foundation Ambassadorial Scholar.


