Last Week's Proceedings (8th December., 2004)

Pres. Rudy welcomed three visiting Rotarians to our meeting today. They are Rtn Kelvin White (South Brisbane, Australia), PP Meggy Tseung (Peninsula Sunrise) & PP John Chan (HKNE).

Pres. Rudy then invited Acting Sergeant-At-Arms John Yao to report on his harvest for today. Rtn John V reported a very good collection of \$1,450.

Pres. Rudy then asked Uncle Peter to explain about our election today. The African ambassador said, "These women are the most beautiful members of one of our tribes. Any one of them will give you a oral sex - take your pick".

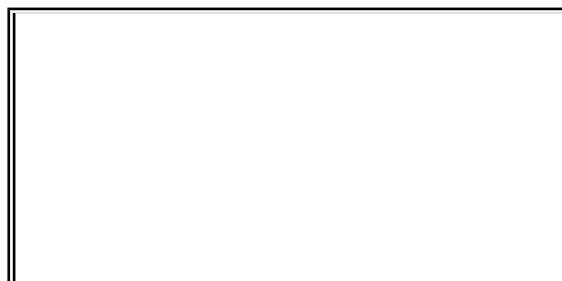

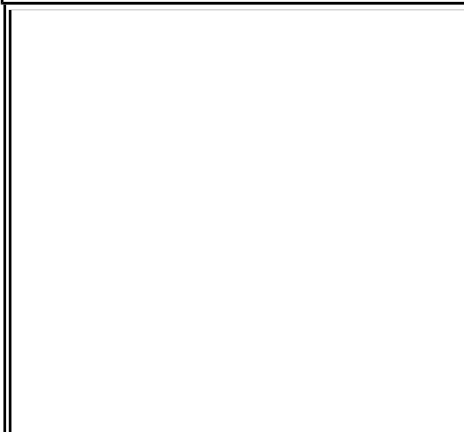

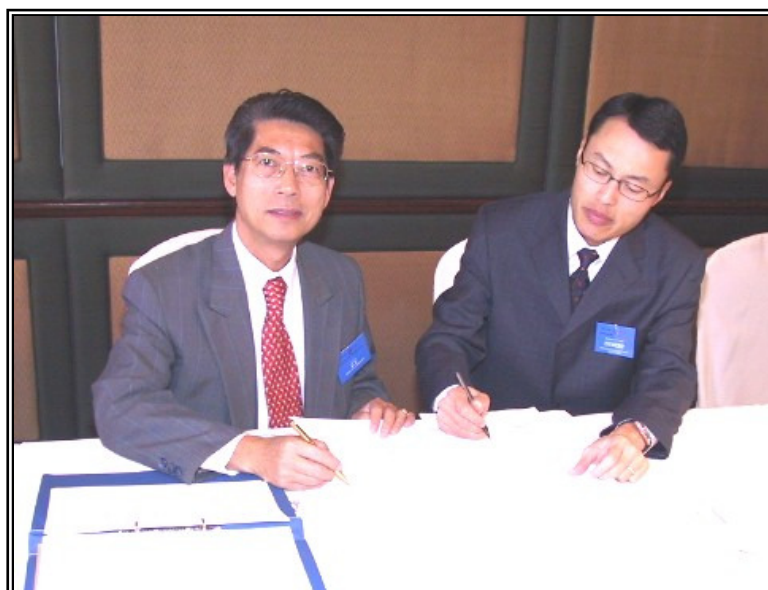
