Pres. Heman then made his announcements.

- 1. Then Pre. Heman asked President Nominee Nancy to introduce our guest speakers Ms Nancy Tsang and Ms Kyoko Leung. Their topic is "The Heep Hong Society & Nancy".

Ms Nancy Tsang is the Director of the "Heep Hong Society" which is a subsidized social welfare organization providing comprehensive services to children with special needs and their parents. "Heep Hong" is currently one of the largest service providers in Hong Kong and serving over 6,000 families each year. For nearly half a century, "Heep Hong Society" has been providing professional training and education to children of different abilities and their families, with the mission of helping these children develop their potential and lead a fulfilling life.

Ms Nancy Tsang graduated from the South Western Medical College in Dallas, U.S. and has been working in the "Heep Hong Society" for over 20 years. She is active in the rehabilitation as well as the education sector and serves on several committees and working groups of the Social Welfare Department, Education Bureau and Hospital Authority. Recently she has been appointed by the HKSAR Government as a member of the Steering Committee of the Community Care Fund.

Nancy gave an introduction and information of Heep Hong Society:

History

Established in 1963 by a group of five Chinese women who were concerned with the welfare of children recovering from poliomyelitis.

Mission

Help children of different abilities reach full potential in a happy and healthy environment, thereby contributing to a more inclusive society.

Service target

Children with different kinds of disabilities:

- Autistic Spectrum Disorder
- Global Developmental Delay
- Specific Learning Difficulties
- Attention-deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Others (sensory impairment, multiple handicap)

Supporting 6,000+ families and their children with special needs

- 12 Early Education & Training Centre.
- 14 Special Child Care Centre.
- 1 Nursery School.
- 5 Parent Resources Centre.
- 2 Centres for Supportive Learning Project.

Long waiting list

- 5,000 subvented pre-school places.
- Heep Hong provides over 50% of places.
- Over 4,000 children on waiting list.
- Average waiting period: 1.5 2 years.

Wan Tsui Centre

- A Special Child Care Centre in Chai Wan.
- 60 children: moderately and severely disabled children aged 2 to 6.
- Provides professional intensive care and training 5 days a week.
- About 50% of the graduates go to mainstream schools every year.

Centre Expansion

- A new extension of 6 units with 3 units not subsidized by government.
- Beneficiaries: 84 centre children and about 300 children on waiting list in Hong Kong East and Kowloon East region.

Facilities in new extension and required funding.

- Adventure Land & Sensory Integrating Room Sponsor secured
- Training Activity, Speech Therapy Rooms plus therapeutic equipment, Cross Motor Room plus play equipment and Sensory Motor Combo HK\$800,000.00 funding required.

Rtn Dr. Tony Loy gave a big thanks to Ms Nancy and Ms Kyoko. He said Heep Hong Society started from Marjong

Table which was similar to the Rotary club started from Lunch table, we should support more to the community same as they do.
