Next Pres. Eric asked SAA William Leung to make his report. He announced that the Red Box collection today was \$1,500.

IT Chair Anthony introduced our speaker for today who was Mr. Eric Cheung of China Light & Power who would speak on their Green Plus Program. The title of his talk was "Powering SMEs the Energy Efficient Way".

He opened his talk by introducing CLP's plans for **Climate Vision 2050**. China Light and Power (CLP) have plans of lowering the CO2 Emissions Intensity of Industries from 0.84kg CO2/kWh in 2007 to 0.2 kgCO2/kWh by year of 2050 and a non-carbon Emission target of 1% in 2007 to 20% by 2050.

But focusing solely on generation side is not enough but should come with greater efforts to promote Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EE &C) on the demand side. They planned to promote Energy Efficiency and Conservation with the community, business customer and residential customer also. They also planned to hold energy audits for business customers & Energy Efficiency Loan scheme. CLP established an interest free loans fund of HK\$125M over 5 years (2009-2013) to assist commercial, industrial and non-governmental customers to implement energy saving projects.

CLP have also promoted their Green Plus Program. This program aims to help SME organization to improve energy efficiency by offering advice to them and also provide them promotion channels to disseminate information. This program offers help on:

- 1) Renewable Application Audit
- 2) Customer Energy Checkups
- 3) Advisory Service for Energy Efficient Building Designs
- 4) Energy Consumption Analysis.

One of these Green Plus Success story is Aquaculture Technologies Asia Ltd. A 3,000 sqM fish farm located at Lau Fau Shan with an annual production of 80,000 grouper fish per year. This was done with energy efficiency improvements measures for heat pump, variable speed drive, solar panels, T5 lighting and evaporation cooler. This resulted on a 20% energy savings, 75 tonnes of carbon emission reduction per annum, all with a 2 years payback on investments.

There were similar savings also shown for other industries such as;

- 1) Spastic Association of HK
- 2) Tai On Chicken Farm
- 3) Cool Kitchen Restaurant
- 4) Tung Fong Hung

Pres. Eric then invited Dr. Freddie Wu to give a vote of thanks to our speaker for such an interesting talk.

Our next weeks' speaker is Mr. Danny Chan, Founder and Co-creator of Appreciation Paragon Ltd., Son of PP Laurence. The topic will be: Introducing a Culture of Praise in Hong Kong.

Pres. Eric then adjourned the meeting by proposing a toast to RI coupled with RC of HK Northeast, RC of Vancouver China Town, RC of Westwood Village, RC of Berlin - Brucke Der Enheit, Germany and Rotary Club of HKIE. He then invited everyone to stay behind for a group photograph.
