### 11th February, 2009

And from the sky comes a booming voice .....

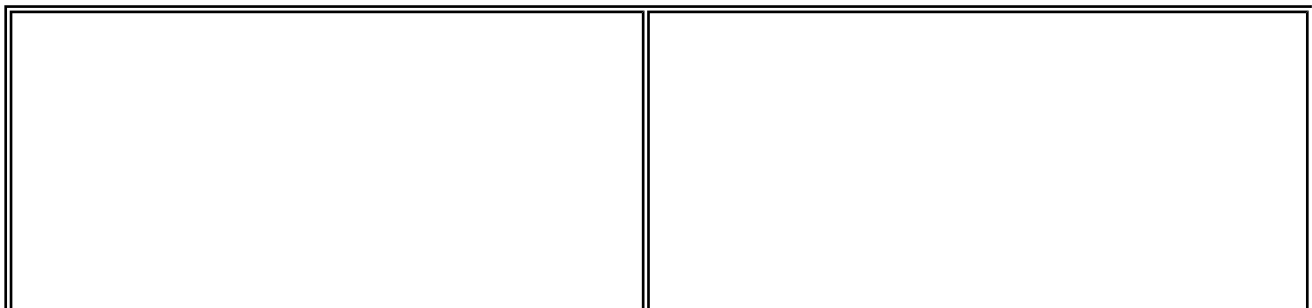
