DGND Eric Chin was invited to introduce our guest speaker, Mr. Lawrence Yuen.

A registered architect in Hong Kong, Lawrence received the Master of Architecture degree from the University of Hong Kong and Master of Business Administration degree from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. With over 16 years of industry experience, Lawrence is the general manager of New World China Land, responsible for overseeing the development and product management of the Group's projects in Southern China.

Lawrence was to share his career development experience in China with the audience.

Lawrence joined New World China Land in 2007 and has been involved in many real estate development projects in China. Some of the projects included China Central Parkview which is one of the most prestigious residential addresses in Guangzhou, large scale commercial and residential projects in southern China, as well as a golf course in Foshan, just to name a few.

As a result of rapid economic growth in the country, the property market has been booming in China. This has created steady growth opportunities for property developers such as New World China Land. The company saw a 6-fold increase in sales volume to HKD17billions from 2005 to 2013.

In the midst of rapid growth, Lawrence and his company would need to constantly adapt to change in order to stay ahead of the competition. Some of the challenges included changing market and business requirements, keeping up with regulatory changes, managing a growing organization, interacting people from other cultural backgrounds, achieving work-life balance, etc.

Lawrence concluded his talk by highlighting a set of considerations for those who may be interested in developing a career in China. The considerations would include proficiency in the language, travel time, mutual respect, mindset turning, continuous learning, family consideration and strong sense of values.

PP Stephen thanked Lawrence for sharing his experience with us and congratulated Lawrence for his vision and foresight in choosing to build his career in China.

The birthday boys were PP David Li and Rtn. Jason Chiu. Led by PP Uncle John and DGND Eric, all members joined in for a birthday song to celebrate this special occasion.
