18th March, 2009

President Andy welcomed our visiting PP Henry Fetigan who resided in Vancouver and belongs to RC of Vancouver China Town and welcomed back to Rtn. William Lamport.

President Andy invited PP Eddy Wong to introduce his guest, Charles Lam. Rtn. William Lamport introduced his son Jonathan Lamport and his guest Henry Cheung. Then Director Dr. Eric introduced his guests Dr. Ann Lee, guest speaker Iris Leung and her colleague Lillian Woo. President Andy also introduced Rotaractor Alysas Yu of Lingnam University and our visiting Ambassadorial Scholar Eddie Walneck.

President Andy expressed congratulation to PP Tim Lui as The HKSAR Government announced on March 16 that the Chief Executive had appointed Mr Tim Lui as Chairman of the Standing Committee on Directorate Salaries and Conditions of Service for a term of two years with effect from April 1, 2009.

Pres. Andy reported the followings and encouraged members to participate:-

- 5. Rtn. Clark Lu will move to Shanghai for his business development.

Acting Sgt. Rudy reported that the Red Box collection was HK\$ 2,000 including a handsome contribution from Rtn. William Lamport.

President Andy invited Director Dr. Eric to introduce the guest speakers. Director Dr. Eric invited Dr. Ann Lee, vice chairman of Anti-Cancer Society, who is the Cluster Chief of Service (Clinical Oncology), Hong Kong Easter Cluster and Chief of Service (Clinical Oncology) Pamela Youde Nethserole Easter Hospital. Dr. Lee thanked for our club's invitation and briefly introduced the Anti-Cancer Society's history and its mission.

Then Director Eric further introduced the guest speaker Ms. Iris Leung who is the General Manager, The Hong Kong Anti-Cancer Society (HKACS), and General Manager (Administration), The Hong Kong Anti-Cancer Society Jockey Club Cancer Rehabilitation Centre. Iris is a professional Physiotherapist. She has a Bachelor of Applied Science (Physiotherapy) and MBA from Australian Graduate School of Management.

Iris told our members that the ACS was established in 1963 as a non-profit making organization. It has always been at the forefront of fighting against cancer and is committed to serving the people of Hong Kong. In addition to providing quality medical services to caner patients, they also organize various activities to raise awareness of cancer, conduct cancer educations, support cancer research, establish guide lines for cancer detection and prevention, and provide direct financial support for cancer patients in needs. Their dedicated volunteers also conduct regular visits and organize recreational activities for caner patients with love and care.

Then Iris further updated the recent great development of HKACS of the Jockey Club Cancer Rehabilitation Centre (JCCRC) which has a 9/F multi-centre Block. This is a brand new concept and services offered to the needy in Hong Kong. It was funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust of an amount HK\$ 109.23 millions. It is operated on a self- financing but not for profit-making basis. It's Mission is to operate JCCRC as a caring "Home Away From Home" providing a wide range of services required by cancer sufferers at different stages of their illnesses; with special emphasis on integrated Western & Chinese medicine, quality nursing care, family support & rehabilitation.

The JCCRC provided a holistic rehabilitation program covering physical aspect, psychological aspect, social aspect and spiritual aspect. Regarding physical aspect, it included integrated medicine consisting western medicine, Chinese medicine and alternative medicine, comprehensive pain management, nutrition support, physiotherapy and home adaptation services. Under psychological aspect, it provided stress management such as counseling service, music relaxation, aroma-therapy, meditation and art therapy. In addition, social aspect was

promoted in terms of recreational diversional therapy, care er empowerment and peer support and volunteers' support activities. Finally, spiritual aspect covered multi-sectors approach and embracing different religions and philosophical beliefs.

Iris stated that HKACS welcomed partnerships with different organization to help HKACS for serving people in HK. She quoted a recent co-operation project: Island Scout Trail walk cum Walk for Life 2009 which was held on 15th March 2009 (Sunday). This project was jointly organized with the Scout of Hong Kong Island Region. The result was encouraging and won many supports from different walks of life

President Andy invited PP Dr. Hubert who is also the Exco members of HKACS to express thanks for Iris's talk.

Pres. Andy adjourned the meeting and made a toast to RI, RC of Vancouver China Town and RC of HKIE.


