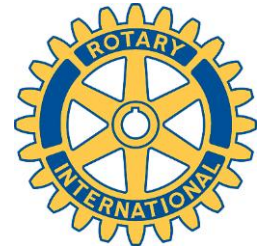

He first introduced his guests his friend Mr. Johnny Cheng and our new candidate for membership Mr. Ronnie Pao who will be inducted today.

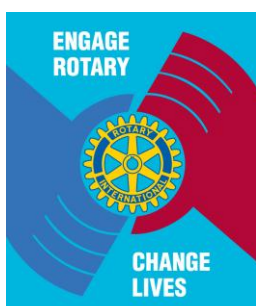
He gave a special welcome to Rotarian (Rtn.) Romana Schuler from the Rotary Club of Gloriette, Vienna, Austria.

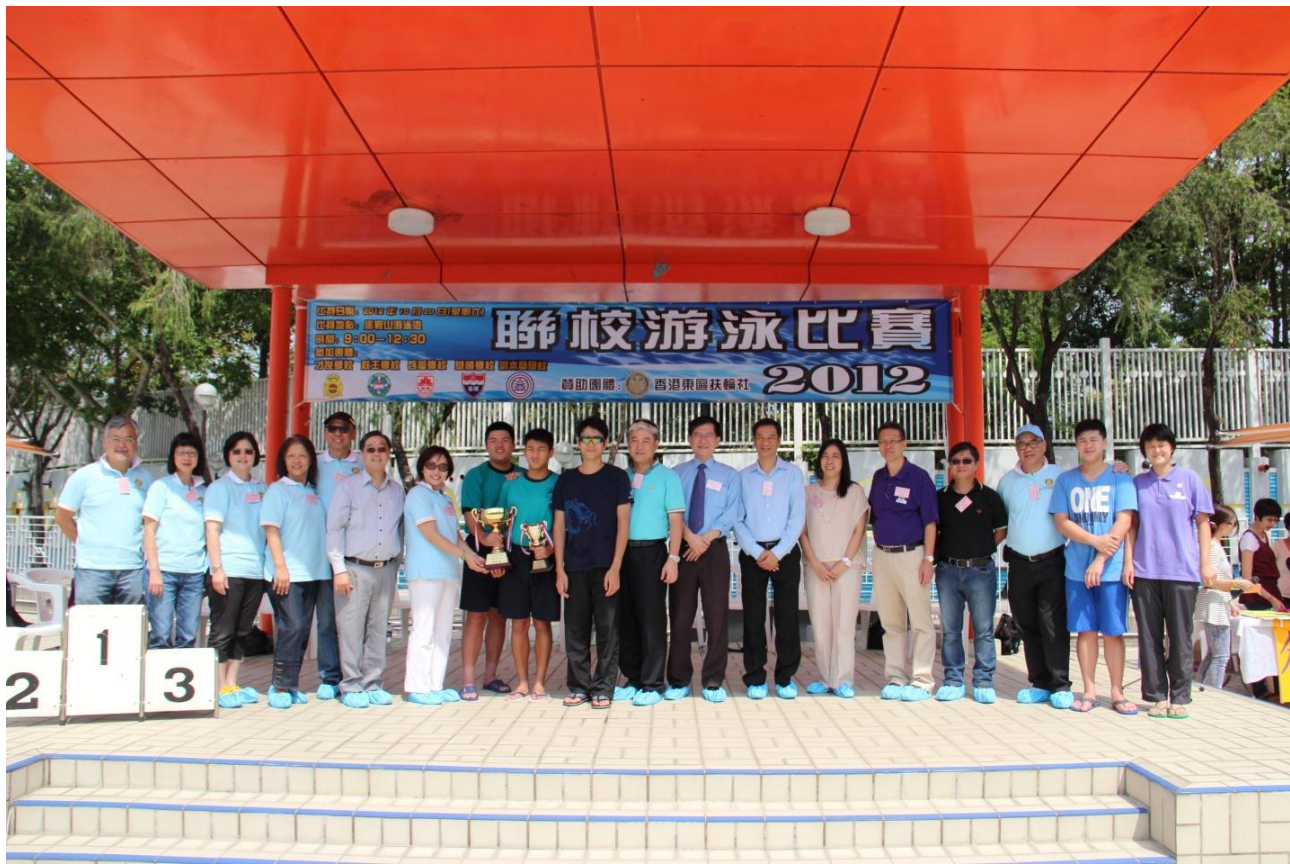
