Then it was the EGM time for our Club and PE Norman took over the forum and briefly explained the background and the detail of the proposed resolution:

- To adopt the amended Byelaws (passed pursuant to Article 33 (e) of the Articles of Association and change of the club due from \$3,000 per half year to \$3,500)
- To change the regular meeting schedule for the first week of every month to a dinner meeting.

Recording Secretary Rtn Avis Kong announced that there were a total of 21 members attended the meeting and had the quorum.

There were some questions and clarification from members on the proposed resolutions and it was duly answered.

Then PP Andrew took over to chair the EGM and the two resolutions were passed without any objection.

The acting SAA IPP Nancy reported a total collection of \$1,900 for the Red Box.

The highlight of today program was the presentation by Mr. Myron Yau of HK BioTek..

Rtn Charles formally introduced the speaker and the subject of the talk was "The Fad Diets in Hong Kong".

Myron is a nutritionist and his company HK Bio Tek Ltd is from Seattle USA.

The company has been set up in Hong Kong for over 10 years and has over 350 professional healthcare partners in HK and Macau.

He first asked what did diet do for us? i.e. for enough energy and for enough nutrients. Then it works out to:

- What you eat
- How much you eat
- When you eat.

He summarized that there were 5 main Fad Diets in HK:

- Atkin's Diet eat meat but no carbohydrates
- Juice Fasting Diet only fresh fruit and vegetable juice
- Mediterranean Diet plenty of rice, noodles, grain products, vegetables, fruit and fish but less meat.
- Vegetarian Diet no meat, only vegetable and grain products
- Raw Foods Diet uncooked food, unprocessed and often organic foods

According to Myron, all these diets have pros and cons and no single diet is suitable for everyone.

However, he stressed that we should not try to stress on only a certain kind of foods. He said the secret of our National Leaders' food diet was"

- Small portion but frequent
- A wide variety of foods
- Daily physical activities

Another area of specialist works for Myron's company was to check on food allergy on people and the chronic symptoms associated with food allergies and how to prevent.

During the question and answer time, Rtn John Yao asked about the usefulness of virgin coconut oil and PP Paul asked about the food diets for diabetes patients.

Rtn Raymond then thanked our speaker and gave his personal viewpoint from a doctor perspective.

Next week programme would be on the topic of "Peace Forum".

President Jonathan formally closed the meeting at 2:05 pm and proposed a toast to RI coupled with RC of New Territories and Hong Kong Island East.
