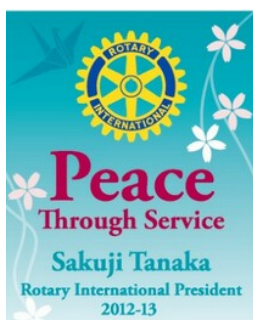
## Last Week's Proceedings – 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2012

**A Perfect Final Activity of Year 2011-2012:  
Match Grant Project: Speech Therapy Resource Center Opening  
Marked the successful partnership with our Sister Club: Rotary Club of Penang**

The Matching Grant Project of US\$ 15,500 of building up a Speech Therapy Resource Center in Choi Jun School kicked off ceremony was held on June 25, 2012 afternoon. It symbolized a perfect final activity of year 2011-2012.

Pres. Eric Chin, PE Nancy Yee, Rtn. William Wong, Rtn. Kevin Leung and District Rotary Foundation Chair PP Kenneth Chow attended the opening with presence of over 100 students and parents. The team joined with Principal Lee, Mr. Chan Kay who is one of the members for the working group (He was an Inspector of EDB for many years and retired some years ago) and Mrs. Tsang the PTA representative officiated the opening ceremony in school hall. President Eric passed the Enlarged Cheque of US\$15,000 to Principal Lee for the kick-off ceremony.

President Eric then delivered a short speech to congratulate the opening of the resource center which helped parents to bring along with the latest speech therapy tools to help the school children who are in acute need for improvement to speak properly. Pres. Eric also stressed that this is an international service project with the support from RC Penang, RI Foundation and District 3450. District RF Chair Kenneth indicated in his speech that he found the project was a meaningful one and could really alleviate the burden of parents to help their children in improving the speaking ability. Thus, he endorsed the program with full confident.

Then, the delegation accompanied by School Speech Therapist Ms Heidi Ip and Ms. Corrie Cheung with over 20 parents visited the Speech Therapy Center. They explained that they have labeled each tool for record of loan out for use at home. They also build up an information system to monitor the borrowing and the return. In addition, they started the 1st stage of purchase of the necessary tools and will launch the second stage of purchase after 3 months of trial run.

Principal Lee expressed his gratitude to all the sponsors for their generosity and support to the school.


