 - We have 2 projects with Choi Jun School – Swimming Above Self Swimming Gala and Happy Luncheons
 - Swimming-Above-Self Swimming Gala
 - Saturday 16 April at Ma On Shan Public Swimming Pool. 4 Mildly Handicapped School students participated.
 - DG Jason who acted as our Guest of Honor, our Rotarians Rtn. William Wong and Fanny Wong, IPP Norman, PE Eric, PN Nancy, Dir. Kevin and Catherine Leung, together with our swimmers Alfred Leung and George Wang from Rotaract Club of HKIE joined the event.

- Alfred Leung and George received the second and 3rd runner up respectively in their legs. For relay, they achieved 2nd runner up. Our Rotaractor Suki and 2 rotaractors from Lingnan U also joined this event.
- Happy Luncheon.
 - Aimed to build up the self-value and confidence for the close-to-graduate students through close contact and having lunch with our Rotarians, and in the process, train up their communication skills, widen their perspectives in dealing with other human beings, raised up their levels of learning.
 - 8 students, age from 16 to 18 were selected by the school based on their attitude and school results. 4 dates were planned on Thursdays and Fridays, which were 21st Oct and 16th Dec in 2010, and 25th Feb, 28th Apr in 2011.
 - 6 members participated, including PP Andy Wong, Rtn William Wong, Rtn. Sharon Lamport, PE Eric Chin, PN Nancy Yee and Pres. Heman. There were 5 students in each group accompanied by 2 teachers, they found their ways to the restaurants with minimal help from the teachers
 - Our heartfelt thanks to PP Andy Wong for organizing the project.
- Building Communities from Build-A-School Project in memory of late Bill Lamport
 - Our service partner is Charity Foundation
 - The building of school initially was located in Guizhou 貴州省 黔南州 惠水縣 長田鄉 建校 冗普小學 where 210 students will be benefited
 - Total amount is HK\$200,000
 - We are to match up funding of the HK\$180,000 from the Lamport's Family.
 - As the provincial government has other plans for the said school, Charity Foundation has offered another school project. The proposal was sent to HS Jonathan for their family's and was approved.
 - Location of the new project is in Guizhou 貴州省 黔南州 惠水縣 寧旺鄉擺壩小學
 - Confirmation was sent to Charity Foundation and await their progress.
 - Thanks to Dir. Kevin Leung and Rtn. William Wong who participated in the foundation laying ceremony of the previous school.
- Water Project with World Vision
 - A clean water supply system was built for a village in Dalinggan Village, Yunan. 雲南省 隴川縣 護國鄉 大嶺幹村民小組 to replace their worn out system currently being used.
 - Provide 70 households / 300 villagers with clean drinking water
 - This is a World Community Service Project with participation from Rotary Club of Niigata. Thanks also to Rtn. Jason Chiu, IPP Norman Lee and Rotarianne Olivia Kan for sponsoring the project.
- Anti-drug Project – Dancing for Healthy Life with Youth Outreach
 - A program organized by Youth Outreach – School of Hip Hop
 - Using street dance as a means to develop personal potential and healthy self-concept to senior primary and secondary school students
 - Serve two schools: St. Louis Primary School and Holy Carpenter Secondary School

- There are total of 13 lessons. 22 students from St. Louis Primary School and 28 students from Holy Carpenter Secondary School participated the program.
 - The program is from September 2010 until May 2011.
 - Graduation public performance and contest as follows:
 - Holy Carpenter Secondary School students performed at Park Central at Tseung Kwan O on 8 May 2011
 - A dance competition “High Schoolers Hip Hop Championship 2011” organized by Youth Outreach was held on 15 May 2011
 - Thanks to Dir. Anthony Kwong who took the lead and organized this project.
- Feed A Child, Build A Nation Matching Grant Project with Rotary Club of Makati North
 - Sponsoring supplementary nutritious lunch feeding program to 200 elementary students in public school of Barangay Sta Cruz & Singkamas
 - Matching Grant approved
 - Project begins from June 2011 for 36 continuous school week
 - Our commitment is US\$5,600
 - Club Administration
 - Website revamp led by IPP Norman
 - District Participations
 - Intercity Meeting, hosted by Area 3 on 17th August 2010
 - District 10k Race - We had 17 runners and 15 cheering team members attended the Race and raised HK\$35,250 for Charity
 - District Conference
 - 13 members participated, 2 teams performing at Rotary Got Talent, 3 spouse and family members and 2 Rotaractors attended District Conference on 19-20 March.
 - The performance teams for Rotary Got Talent Performance at Governor’s Banquet - Ivan Chin, the son of PE Eric, received The Most Talented Award and son and daughter-in-law of PP John Luk, Johnson and Lucia received The Most Poetic Performance Award.
 - Thanks to PP Eddy Wong, IPP Norman Lee and PP Andy Wong who presented our Signature Projects in Rotary Share Sessions. Our flagship project Swimming-Above-Self, as presented by PP Andy Wong received The Best Community Service Award.
 - We passed the baton as we attended District Assembly.
