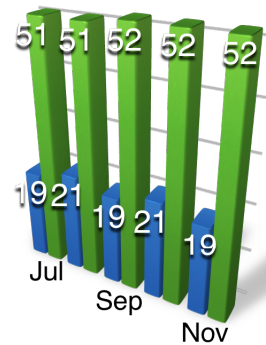

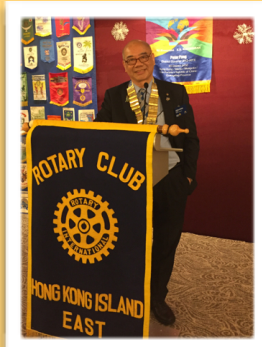

A married couple had been out shopping for most of the day on New Year Eve.

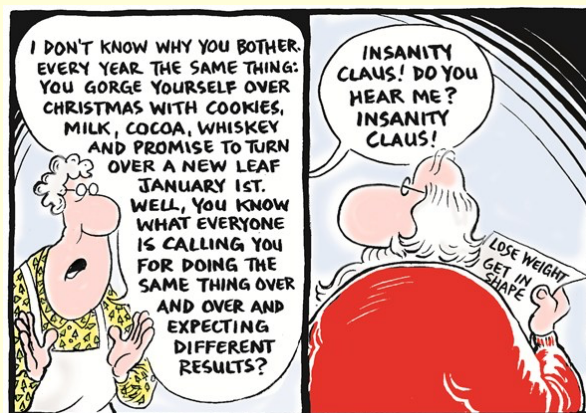
Suddenly the wife realised that her husband had "disappeared".
