## President's Message - A star show



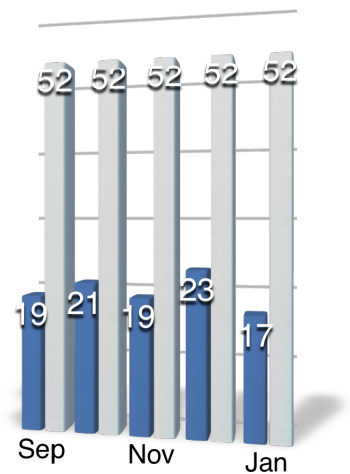
