Spotlight On - District Mongolia Projects



This project is a District initiative as part of this year's Serving Humanity Marketplace, as instigated by DG Eric. There are 7 projects proposed by Mongolia Rotary Clubs (our Hong Kong/Macao Clubs will join in 3 of the projects) and there are also 8 projects proposed by Mongolia Rotaract Clubs (our Hong Kong/Macao Clubs will join in 3 of the projects).

The projects are designed to bring a closer link between Clubs in Hong Kong & Macao with Clubs in Mongolia; and enhance our collaboration within RID 3450, and address the needs of the underprivileged groups in Mongolia. DS Eliza outlined the specific of the projects, which include

- School sanitation organized by Niislet Rotary Club. Designed to improve sanitation in schools for children from 6 years upwards, and also disabled.
- Aгаа-Egee mentoring Program. It seeks to connect youth who reside in the National Mongolian State Orphanage to be dedicated, responsible, motivated and civically engaged adults, who can foster caring relationships and guide them in their professional interest and transition into adulthood.
- Child Online Protection program, designed to educate children about the dangers that can be found on the internet, the messages will be delivered via comic books, school posters and training sessions.
