President's Message - Fighting modern slavery



A couple of years ago, a man called Matt Friedman was invited as guest speaker at our club, and his topic was 'Modern Slavery' or human trafficking, a little talked about (comparatively) but enormously tragic global situation which exists all around us. Matt works for The Mekong Club, a Hong Kong based group made up of business people dedicated to tackling the issue of modern slavery, about the millions of poor unfortunate people who are abducted around the world and forced to work in extreme conditions for little or no money. Imprisoned by trickery and deceit. After the presentation, I kept in touch with Matt, and offered my help to him in any way possible. Helping him to raise awareness about the issue, which I have been doing outside of Rotary. This summer, along

with his wife Sylvia, Matt has embarked on a 70-day road trip across the USA, taking the story to a variety of organisations in different cities, to not only create awareness about modern slavery, but also try to involve companies to do their part (especially where cheap labour in Asian countries is concerned). The goal was to do 100 presentations in all (as I write he has done 96). According to his findings so far, he concludes 'General awareness about the topic is low in every category (business, business coalition, Rotary, school, faith based and the general public).

There is no repository for basic information and data on this topic anywhere'. This is

an amazing story about a very dedicated man, who lives and breathes this cause. I also think it's an issue that Rotary should get behind. We have the resources, we have the people who care. A man left for work one Friday afternoon. Instead of going home, he stayed out the entire weekend hunting with the boys and spending all his wages.


When he finally got home on Sunday night, he was confronted by his very angry wife.
