He was a music major in CUHK/HKAPA, and had zero background in advertising communication before he entered the advertising industry. He has worn many hats: Full time advertising, part time in teaching, writing column in different media. Public speaking and teaching for his living. Rudi was very shy when he was a kid, and typical introvert. He confirmed that most of us in the room had a social media account, which he said nowadays is like an extension of your profile. In the old days you have to write a very good c.v., now you need to actively manage your social media profile. Get endorsement from your peers professionally or personally.

10 STEPS TO A BETTER IMAGE:

- 1. Don't be ambiguous about your relationship status, no need to hide when you open a friendship
- 2. Write a respectable personal description, be straight forward, simple, witty & fun. He likes "hair icon" from Hillary Clinton's profile.
- 3. Take a respectable profile picture. Perfect example from Steve Jobs. From 1998-2010 have a similar personality in different platform.
- 4. Be consistent and be your best self in Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat.
- 5. Always bring value to a social conversation, share good article, funny video, something important. Barack Obama is a good example in sharing moment.
- 6. Think twice before you share any news or article. A lot of fake news actually confused people on social media. Such as secret tips to get healthy are actually fake, just want to attract traffic.
- 7. Don't be a grumpy cat or sad dog, never publicly bitch/whine
- 8. When you're sick, don't tell Facebook
- 9. Stay away from being a Selfie Queen
- 10. Facebook to change News feed to focus on Friend and Family. When you like a post or whatever content on Facebook, Facebook will study your activity and feedback the type of content Facebook think that you'll like to you. This will narrow the things you're going to see. Have to be very cautious, social media feed you something they think that you like.
