



Spotlight On - Why invest in your brand?



In case you didn't know, P Chris works in advertising and has enjoyed a long career helping represent many famous brands in Hong Kong and the world. This particular presentation is one that he gave at the PR Workshop last year, in which he relates his concepts about brand building to the Rotary name. He began by listing out a number of sloid business reasons why it pays to invtest in your brand name, sharing some of the world's famous brands such as Coca Cola, Apple, Google, Microsoft among others. P Chris pointed out that a strong brand name can help sales, help get introduced to new markets, attract investors and partners, and give more clout to your advertising spending. He then spoke about the Rotary brand, and gave some personal viewpoints about how Rotary could do a better job of promoting its name around the world. Such as:

- Be more consistent with its brand image (he shared examples of Rotary designs looking very different, country to country.
- Be more bold showing examples of good Rotary brand on premiums like t-shirts and caps, where the Rotary logo and message was big and bold.
- Use social media to promote what we do, not what a good time we are always having. Show more of our service projects and less parties, which he explained only please Rotarians, not non-members.
