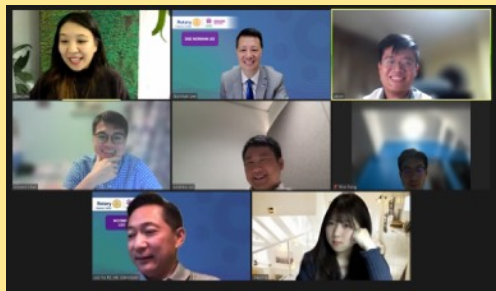

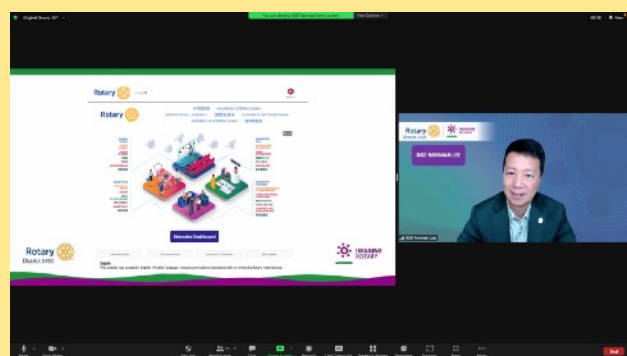
### Virtual Rotary Exchange

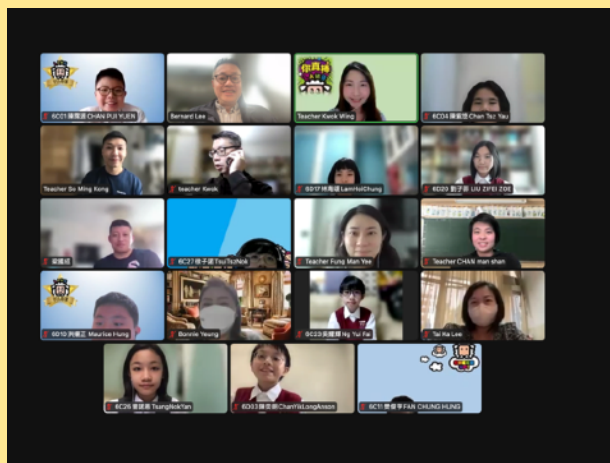
