The 62nd District Conference was held at Nina Hotel, Tsuen Wan. P Bernard, PDG Y.K., DGE Norman, IPP Leo, PP William, PP Eddy, PE Rico and Rtn Eric were there.

Registration started 11am on Saturday, 28 May 2022. Day one programme included opening ceremony, and sharing from Guest of Honor Mr. Philip Chan, Chairman of The Hong Kong Jockey Club. PDG Y.K. gave vote of thanks on behalf of District.



DG Keith gave his report for the year, followed by online address from RI President Shekhar Mehta. District Rotaract Representative Luffy Chan introduced the RI President's Personal Representative (RIPPR) RI Director-nominee Ghim Bok Chew, who then gave his address.

In the afternoon, we were split into 5 breakout sessions focusing on change and sustainability through Rotary, and reports on the sessions were given before the day ended.



Day two featured the second plenary session presided by DGE Norman in the morning. The keynote speaker was Mr. Donald Choi, Executive Director and CEO of Chinachem Group. RIPPR Ghim Bok Chew reported state of Rotary worldwide. PDG Ada Cheng gave her report on the 2022 Council on Legislation. PDG Y.K. conducted the adoption of Conference Resolutions. District Financial Statement for Rotary Year 2020-2021 were adopted. Contributions to the Rotary Foundation were also recognized.

DGN Andy Li and Conference Chair DS Elizabeth Fong presided the third and fourth plenary sessions. Keynote speaker Ng On-Yee, young world championship snooker player, shared her story on stage, and all District leaders of Rotaract, Interact and Junioract youth programmes gave summary of this Rotary year.

Highlight of the programme comes back to the people of Rotary. Service projects, presidents and clubs are recognized. We all got to know more about DGE Norman through his dialogue on stage. We were all encouraged to sign up for RI Convention 2022 at Houston and 2023 at Melbourne. The 63rd District Conference, scheduled for 21-22 May 2023, is now in my diary.

As some of us attended the Conference the second or third time around, we pick up more nuances and gain deeper understanding into Rotary.
