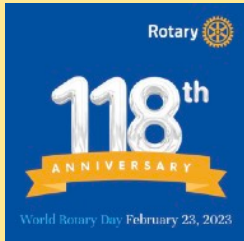

Can you recognise any faces?



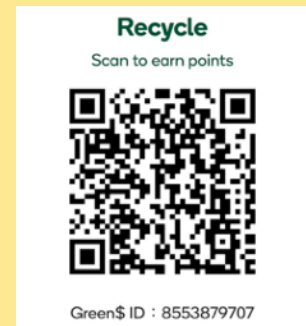
