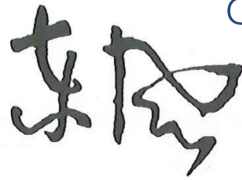

On 22 October, 2023, President Rico Fung, PP Leo Yu and his wife Sally, PP Nancy Yee, PP William Wong and his wife Fanny, PP Stacy Ho, and our newest member Lawrence Lui participated in one of our 70th anniversary service projects focused on providing healthcare for the elderly.

The Elderly HealthCare Foundation Limited is responsible for providing this "老有所醫" service. As the first initiative of its kind in Hong Kong on a venue basis, the foundation has formed partnerships with various NGOs, such as The Neighborhood Advice-Action Council, as well as medical societies and organizations including The Pharmaceutical Society of Hong Kong, The Chiropractor Association, Hong Kong Pain Society, Eye Care Charitable Foundation, PPDH Voluntary Dental Group, and more.

Qualified elderly individuals who meet requirements will have access to surgery procedures such as colonoscopy, lump and bump surgery, minor orthopedic surgery, and more.

Additionally, Knee Replacement Surgery is available for eligible individuals who require it. This surgical procedure aims to address knee-related issues and improve mobility and quality of life for those in need.
