President's Report came next:

- On our 70th anniversary celebration, production house and financials were being reviewed. Any signing would be scheduled after our second club assembly. Consideration for the harborfront sculpture would need to be postponed due to arrangements from the Government on the venue. Details on exhibitions at MTR were pending confirmation.

- On Foundation, PP Eddy Wong and PP William Wong were recognized as new and second Paul Harris Fellows respectively.
- Community Services were as covered by our Club announcements.
