PP Gilbert Fung introduced our speaker, Mr. Tommy Cheng. Mr. Cheng's business was inspired by a Japanese cartoon Doraemon, where the robot cat from the future create a clone for its owner so he can be at multiple places and doing multiple things at the same time.



The “Digital Twin”, made possible by modern Artificial Intelligence technologies, will be able to speak fluently in dozens of languages, in the highly believable voice of the original key opinion leader. While this technology is not new or exclusive, Tommy had partnered with the right technology provider to support Cantonese, which is unique in this area.

Over 600 Million people watch TikTok every day. While it is an excellent platform for exposure and promotion, it takes time and resources to create each short video. The “Digital Twin” technology will help reduce the cost and repetitive work required for creating a large number of short videos on a daily basis.

The presentation had aroused curiosity and interesting questions from our members. PP Bernard Lee gave vote of thanks to Mr. Cheng in the usual Rotarian manner.
