President Rico declared the meeting open. We celebrated the birthday of Rtn Jason Chiu.

Our club already put together a team for Ultramarathon and called upon us to join. District Conference will also be coming soon. There is also the President Elect Training Seminar.

PP Leo also gave report on behalf of PP William Wong on International services. All invitations to our sister clubs for our 70th Anniversary Celebration had been sent. 20 from Taipei South Sea will be coming to Hong Kong.

PE Bonnie reported on our service projects. There will be an upcoming service with the Mobile Clinic project. PE Bonnie will be joining with her role as Pharmacist. Our Longevity Design House project had been completed, with more than 100 households being served. The MTR exhibitions would start end of April, in Sheung Wan and Sai Wan Ho Stations. We will be showcasing the history of our Club, and the winning entries of the photo competition.

We have 225 entries from 48 high schools and 90 entries from 14 primary schools for our photo competition. The award ceremony will be held on 20 March 2024.

PP Bernard Lee reported on Youth Services. Rotaract Club of HKCC Students' Union will be renamed. Hong Kong Polytechnic University would like to promote the College of Professional and Continuing Education branding. A visit to Hong Kong Cyberport had also been organized to introduce their incubation and funding programs and their showcase incubated projects to the Rotaractors.



There will be two musical performances by Junioract Club of CCC Kai Wan Primary School (Aldrich Bay) in the Hong Kong Station on 27 April 2024 and 3 May 2024. Mr. Jeff Sze, Under Secretary for Education of HKSAR, will attend the latter.

# **Dinner Registration**

To meet minimum hotel banquet guarantee, we need to secure 48 tables @ 10 persons per table. We hope to have 480 participants.

To date (20 March 2024), we have:

- A. 8 tables for our current Club members confirmed attending (each with one guest/spouse; tickets included in Club dues);
- B. 6 of our members have purchased one additional table or part thereof. This results in an equivalent 6 tables;
- C. 5 tables for Sister Club members;
- D. 1 table of VIP including Guest of Honour, DG, DGE and their spouse;
- E. 2 tables of 'partners in service' such as Kei Wan School principal, our Anniversary project partners, sergeants, ...,

totalling 22.

- F. 7 Clubs (HK North, HK South, HK Harbour, HK Northeast, HK North Point cum Braemar Hill, Happy Valley, The Hub HK) from 4 Clans and 5 (Hong Kong, HK Island West, Green HK, Star Avenue, Tsim Sha Tsui) from non 4 Clans have confirmed one table each. That will be 12:
