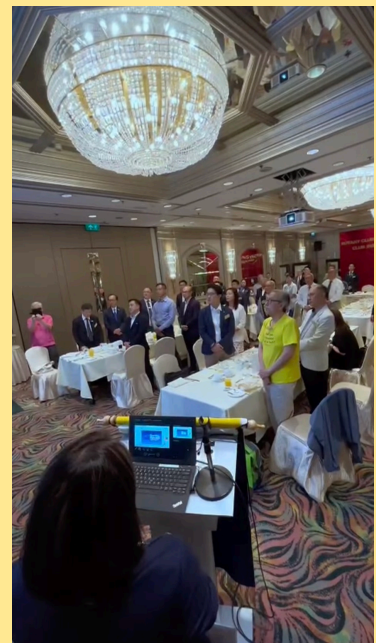
Thank you again for this honour. I am humbled, energised, and ready to get to work.”
