Membership

Attendance rates had improved. To date, we have received 97 visiting Rotarians, primarily through our four Clans Meeting featuring Professor the Hon. Lo Chung Mau. Participation from Rotaractors has also increased. Attendance includes participation in fellowship and service projects.

Currently, our Club has 44 members. We welcomed one new member, Rotarian Tommy Yeung. We lost 3 members due to relocation or work commitments. We have 25 Past Presidents and 19 Rotarians, of whom 20 are Senior Active members.

Finance

RI will increase membership fees to US\$100 per year. The Club’s dues will be adjusted accordingly to cover this increase, as well as our ongoing commitment to Every Rotarian, Every Year contribution.

Club dues invoices for January to June 2026 have been issued. Past President Rico Fung will follow up with all members.

Community Service

The Student Smart Phone Photo Contest attracted over 800 participants this year, more than double the number from last year.

In early October, we collaborated with our “recently reinstated” Rotaract Club of Lingnan University to conduct an e-sports program for the elderly. President Cyrus Cheung visited participating elderly centres, and the e-sports finals will be held later this year.

The Tennis Experience Day will continue this coming weekend.

Youth Service

This year, Youth Service has been more integrated into our Club's service and fellowship activities, such as the e-sports and social enterprise ethical consumption projects. Besides the Rotaract Club of Lingnan University, the Junioract Club of CCC Kei Wan Primary School (Aldrich Bay) and the Rotaract Club of PolyU CPCE are very active.



International Service

The next RI Convention will be held from 13 to 16 June 2026 in Taipei. There will be two Grand Opening Sessions on 13 June.

A fellowship event will be held on 13 June with members of our sister clubs attending the Convention. Past President William Wong will provide further details by email.

We had made our donation for tuk tuk for students in Cambodia. President Lawrence will arrange a visit.

Our sister club in Makati North has invited us to participate in a hurricane relief program for fishermen, involving the donation of 100 boats at US\$170 each. The Club has committed to sponsoring four boats, totaling US\$680.

Vocational Service

PP Leo shared with us how vocational service set Rotary apart from other NGOs. It encourages Rotarians to mentor others and fosters international goodwill. It reflects how we live our Rotary values by upholding high ethical standards and applying our professional skills in service to others. Vocational Service opens doors,
