Our **3rd Club Assembly on 18 March 2026** brought together members to review progress, celebrate achievement, and align on priorities for the final quarter of the Rotary year.

Members celebrated the birthdays of PP Andy Wong and Rtn. Jason Chiu.

President Lawrence Lui informed members of the **District Conference on 30–31 May**, with the Club sponsoring eight members, priority given to new members like **Rtn Bennet Tsui & Rtn Tommy Yeung**.



He also highlighted the **Rotary International Convention in Taipei from 13 to 17 June**.

On Club announcement, President Lawrence reminded members of the **72nd Anniversary Celebration Dinner** on 1 April at Regal Hongkong Hotel, featuring performance arranged by PP Nancy Yee and fellowship games organised by PDG Norman Lee. Members were encouraged to invite their families and friends.

Upcoming meetings include a dinner meeting on 15 April with **Dr. Keith Wan, team doctor of the Hong Kong football team**, and speakers **PP Tim Lui** and **PP Jonathan Lamport** in May. This Rotary year will conclude with the final Club Assembly in June.



President Lawrence presented his report for the **3rd Club Assembly**, structured around the three pillars of deepening membership, empowering youth, and sustainable service. The Club currently has 42 members, with two new members and three resignations during the year. Over 20 service projects have been completed, exceeding targets. Contributions to the Annual Fund and PolioPlus Fund have also surpassed expectation. Participation in social activities and district engagement remains an area for further development.



Hon. Secretary PP Nancy Yee presented the **attendance report**, noting a decline in Q3 due to the Chinese New Year period, fewer meetings, and the absence of large-scale events. Eight members achieved 100% attendance, namely President Lawrence Lui, PDG Y.K. Cheng, PP Nancy Yee, PP Rico Fung, PP William Wong, Rtn Christian Li, PP Stacy Ho, and Rtn Bennet Tsui. President Lawrence Lui, PDG Y.K. Cheng, PP Nancy Yee, and PP Rico Fung were also recognised for maintaining perfect attendance over nine consecutive months. Members with lower attendance were identified to foster make up.

President Lawrence then presented the financial update on behalf of Hon. Treasurer PP Rico Fung, noting that while current-year accounts are in order, **outstanding records** from previous years are being followed up by a subcommittee led by PDG Norman Lee.

IPP Bonnie Yeung reported that Rtn Bennet Tsui and Rtn Tommy Yeung have recently joined the Club and completed **new member orientation**. They were encouraged to maintain active in Rotary activities.

Rtn Jason Chiu reported that the **Uncle Peter Hall and Uncle John Kwok Memorial Golf Day** had been postponed due to low response. A smaller gathering was suggested. The rescheduled fellowship will be held at Kau Sai Chau (South Course) on either Friday, 15 May or Friday, 22 May.



PP Bernard Lee reported on youth initiatives. Charter President Cyrus Cheung of the **Rotaract Club of Lingnan University** shared insights on the re-establishment of the Club at a joint Rotaract fellowship and gathering. In May and June 2026, our Club will host participants from the **Child Development Initiative Alliance (CDIA) Youth Work Explorer (Y-WE) program** - a Hong Kong initiative providing underprivileged youth with mentorship and work placements - at our regular meetings to further enhance their social mobility and professional exposure.

A cross-generational initiative with the **Junioract Club of CCC Kei Wan Primary School (Aldrich Bay)** where students will demonstrate Ba Duan Jin (Tai Chi) movements to kindergarten students and seniors, fostering leadership while providing the elderly with vital social engagement and critical improvement in physical balance and lower limb strength, which are essential for maintaining mobility and preventing fall.

President Lawrence Lui then reported on behalf of Rtn Christian Li, Community Service Director. The Club has completed over 20 service projects across **youth empowerment, cross-generational service, and community development**. These include the Smartphone Photo Competition, Joint Rotaract Vocational Day, Children's Heart Foundation Charity Walk, regular elderly outreach, and the Dental Truck Project.



Highlighted projects included the **Rotary Ethical Consumerism Weekend**, which generated approximately HK\$30,000 in support of social enterprises. The Magic of Tennis Project will continue on 18 April in collaboration with Po Leung Kuk primary school and the Rotaract Club of Lingnan University. The Go Chess Kindergarten Programme, delivered by **Rotaractors from PolyU CPCE**, has reached approximately 100 students, with the final competition scheduled for 26 April.

On international service, the Club donated US\$1,500 to the **Cambodia Children Advocacy Association** to replace a damaged school vehicle.

The new vehicle now enables children in rural communities to travel safely to school, restoring access to education and daily stability for families.

The Club also supported the Rotary Club of Makati North "**Banca for Life**" project, contributing to a total of 21 fishing boats donated by the Club and its members to support affected communities.

The boats are being constructed and deployed to help affected fishing families rebuild their livelihoods with renewed dignity and hope.

PP William Wong then updated members on the **Rotary International Convention in Taipei**, which will include sister club visits, local tours, and fellowship activities, with approximately ten members and spouses expected to attend.

Since quorum was not met, the **EGM would be postponed to 24 June**. President Lawrence explained that the proposed membership fee adjustment aims to support a US\$100 per member contribution to The Rotary Foundation and strengthen funding for service projects.



PP George Leung also shared that the Club's membership fee had remained unchanged for many years, and expressed his support for the proposed adjustment as a necessary step to keep pace with inflation and ensure sufficient resources for future service initiatives. Members suggested the Board to provide further details.

PP Andy Wong reported the total Red Box collection for the day of HK\$1,020.
