The Rotary Club of Hong Kong Island East celebrated its **72nd Anniversary** on 1 April 2026 with a gala dinner at Alto 88, 31/F, Regal Hong Kong Hotel.

The evening was themed “**Celebrating Our Rotary Roots – Chicago 1905, Where It All Began**”, a fitting tribute to the founding of Rotary International by Paul Harris in Chicago in 1905, and to our own Club’s rich legacy spanning over seven decades.

The evening commenced at 6:30 pm with a reception, warmly hosted by **IPP Bonnie Yeung**, who served as the evening’s MC. Following the Rotary Song and guest introduction, President Lawrence Lui delivered his welcome address, in which he traced the proud history of our Club. Chartered on **6 April 1954** as Club No. 16340 of District 3450, with **PDG John Yuen** serving as our founding Charter President. Over 72 years, the Club has grown in membership, service and fellowship, inspiring generations of Rotarians and even spinning off new clubs.

The award presentation segment, conducted jointly by President Lawrence and **AG Wilson Shum**, was a highlight of the evening. The Club recognised its **Paul Harris Fellows** and **Club Service sponsors**, honouring the remarkable contributions of members and supporters to Rotary’s mission. The most touching moment of the evening came with the presentation of the **50th Year Service Award** to two long-serving pillars of our Club: **PP Andrew Chen** and **PP George Leung**. Their half-century of dedication to Rotary stands as a testament to the enduring spirit of service above self.

The celebration continued with a lively cake cutting ceremony and group photo. The Club’s 72nd birthday cake was a centrepiece of the evening, as President Lawrence led members and guests in a joyful celebration of this momentous milestone, together with the birthdays of PP George Leung and PP Tajwar Shadikhan.





The entertainment programme that followed was a delight for all. First to take the stage was **Rtn Bill Ng** (吳大強) of the Rotary Club of Kowloon West, a performer from the popular TVB programme *Midlife Singing* (中年好声音), who treated the audience to a spirited set of four songs.

Next came one of the most memorable segments of the evening: the **Violin Playing Game**, led by **PDG Norman Lee** and **PP Hubert Chan**. PP Hubert's violin playing and PDG Norman's playful hosting turned the occasion into a wonderful interactive experience for all present. The final entertainment highlight of the



evening was **CP Roy Tang** of the Rotary Club of Dragon Hong Kong, another beloved performer from *Midlife Singing*, who performed five songs to close out the entertainment programme in style. His warm and energetic performance brought the audience to their feet.



The fun continued with a **Kahoot** quiz organised by **Rtn Christian Li**, testing members' knowledge of Rotary and our Club's history — all in the spirit of fellowship and friendly competition.

A spirited **Whisky Auction** of three bottles, led by **PP Stacy Ho**, added further excitement to the evening.

President Lawrence Lui closed the evening with a heartfelt toast, expressing gratitude to all members, guests, donors and sponsors for their generous support of the Club's service projects throughout the year. Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) Notice

Notice is hereby given that an **Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM)** of the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Island East Limited will be held as follows:

Date: Wednesday, 6 May 2026
Time: 13: 00 hours sharp
Venue: Regal Hong Kong Hotel, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong

There shall be **FOUR agenda items** for discussion and approval:

1. To amend Article 11, Section 2 for an adjustment to the annual Full membership fees to HK\$8,000 (half year due HK\$4,000) commencing from the Rotary Year 2026 – 27 to enable a contribution of US\$100 per member to the Rotary Foundation. (Senior Member Full Membership fee to be HK\$5,434; half year due HK\$2,717.)

The proposal has been endorsed by the Board.

2. To amend Article 23, Section 2 of the Club Bylaws – The regular weekly meetings of this Club shall be held on Wednesday at 13:00 hours.

Proposed amendment: Regular meetings shall be held every two weeks, with the first week on Wednesday at 13:00 hours and the third week on Wednesday at 19:00 hours.

3. To amend Article 23, Section 4 of the Club Bylaws – Regular meetings of the Board shall be held on the second Thursday of each month.

Proposed amendment: The President and the Board shall determine the schedule of regular Board meetings annually.

4. To incorporate online participation by members for Annual General Meetings (AGMs), Extraordinary General Meetings (EGMs), and Board Meetings (BMs), if approved by the Board on a case-by-case basis.

The quorum for the EGM based on current membership strength, as stipulated by the Club's constitution, is 14 members. The resolution will be passed by a clear majority of votes from members present.

Your attendance and participation are important to ensure we meet the quorum and collectively decide on this matter.
